What to bring for wreath and centerpiece making:

Donated holiday greens such as bows of short-leaved evergreens, magnolia leaves, cones, holly, pyracantha stems with berries, and other decorative greenery that stands up to the weather. Bring your wreathing rings if you have some, your hand pruners, floral wire, and wire clippers, but the chapter has a supply of all of these items if you do not.

What to bring for the potluck?

We're keeping it simple this year with one main dish being provided: Brunswick Stew. If interested here is my recipe, minus the meat:

1. Bring **COOKED** meats to add to the stew like a salad bar. That way you can add whatever meat(s) you wish to your individual bowl of stew. Suggestions: diced cooked ham, ground beef, chopped or shredded BBQ'd anything, shredded chicken breast, venison, stewed beef, small chunks of any kind of sausage, crab or shrimp meat, etc.
2. Munchies/appetizers for the social, bread and desserts for the dinner.
3. Bring your favorite big mug or soup bowl and a personal spoon for your bowl of stew. Do not bring disposables! We have an ample supply of utensils, plates, napkins, hand towels, cups etc. Our goal this year is to minimize our trash creating only compostable refuse.
